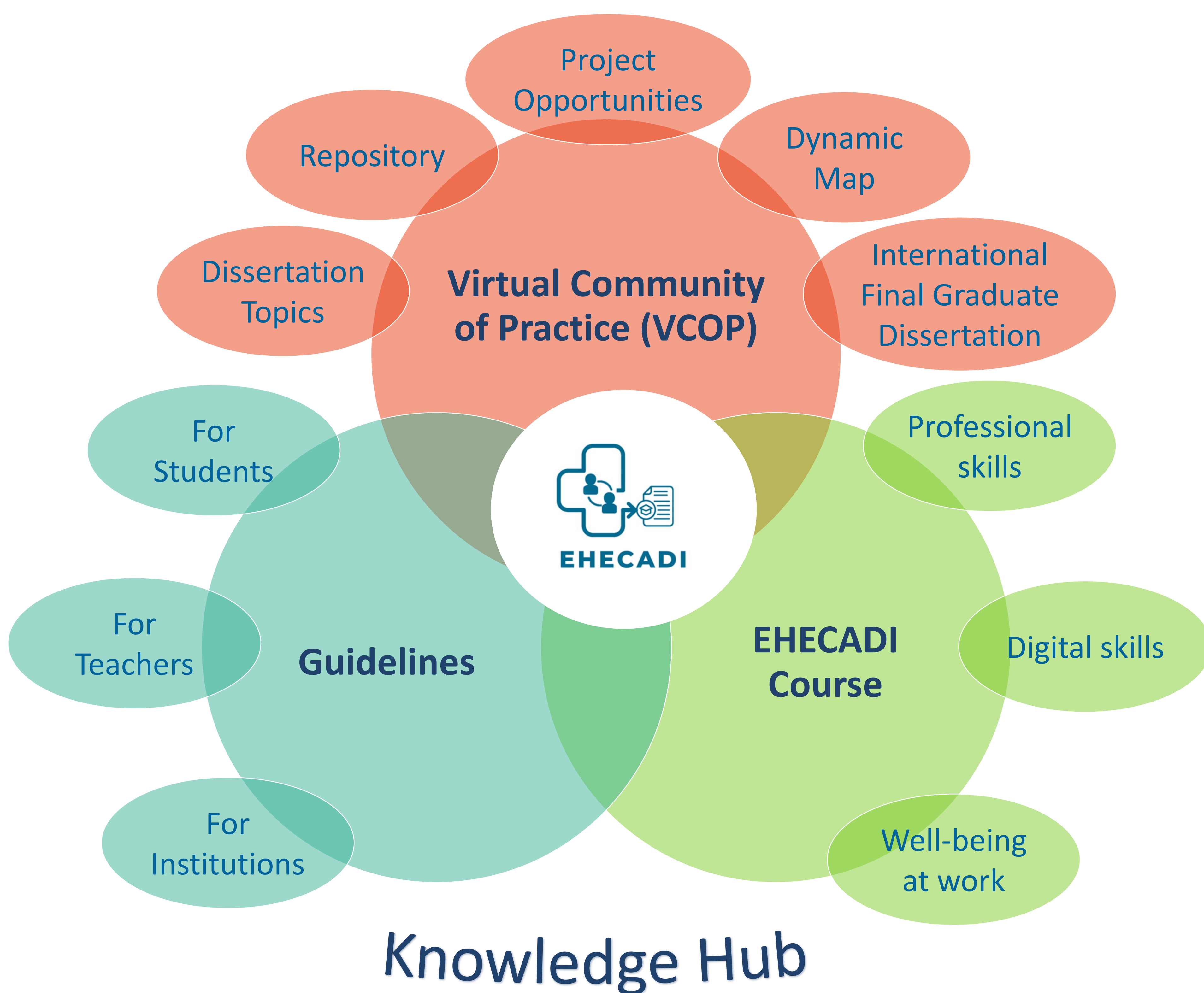
What is the aim of the EHECADI project?
